Saturday, February 3rd, 2024 marks the date for the Nathan Yip Foundation's Annual Chinese New Year Gala. Through funding and collaborative support, our vision is to close the education and opportunity gap between rural and urban schools in the state. Projects have ranged from STEAM technology classroom upgrades to online resources and funds for districts to enhance vocational programs, as well as funding to support student visits to

Our Chinese New Year Gala, in addition to being one of the largest Chinese New Year celebrations in the state, is also our largest fundraiser - the money raised at the Gala is granted shortly thereafter to schools and districts. Our event will once again be at the Grand Hyatt and we will be ringing in the Year of the Dragon. Guests will be treated to a banquet dinner, our popular Night Market, and a live auction and paddle raiser for rural school support. The event will be chaired this year by Dr. Michael and Lyn Schaffer. Dr. Schaffer has worked extensively in rural Colorado in his medical practice and thus has seen first-hand the need for education support in rural areas. Lyn Schaffer brings extensive experience in chairing incredible events, so we are excited to have their passion and experience as we work to create a memorable experience for our 400+ guests.

Agate School District | Agate, CO East Grand School District | Granby, CO

Industrial Arts Equipment. Fund the purchase of new large equipment (including saws) to improve the safety and relevance of the industrial arts program.

Bennett School District | Bennet, CO

Fire Sciences Pathways Program. Fund industry standard equipment and supplies so students in Bennett and surrounding areas can attain their Fire Science Certification while in high school.

Canon City School District | Canon City, CO **Delta County School District | Delta, CO RE-2 School District | Rifle, CO**

Good-Natured Learning: Support districts in district-wide implementation of effective nature-based learning by funding training for Good Natured Learning Teacher Fellows that will support and train others in the districts.

WHY RURAL? OUT OF SIGHT, OUT OF MIND

Nathan Yip, after visiting China as a teen with his family, felt a strong urge to help schools and students in rural areas of China. To honor his memory and turn their grief into meaningful action, Nathan's parents dedicated themselves to raising funds in support of his vision for enhancing rural education. Since 2016, the Nathan Yip Foundation has focused on improving education in rural Colorado. Through initiatives like school and district grants, as well as grants for rural teachers, the foundation continues to actively support K-12 education in these areas. By directly providing funding for specific needs identified by rural educators, we aim to positively impact the educational journey of students in rural Colorado. Our goal is to narrow the educational disparities between rural and urban schools. Together, we can make a significant difference in ensuring that every student in rural Colorado has access to a high-quality eduction, exciting opportunities, and the resources they need to succeed. RURAL COLORADO TEACHER GRANTS

Established in 2022, the Nathan Yip Foundation awards grants to rural Colorado teachers.

147 districts in the state of Colorado (out of 179 districts statewide) are identified by the Colorado Department of Education as rural or small rural. The Nathan Yip Foundation aims to support teachers in these rural districts with rural teacher grants. Projects funded include a microscale chemistry lab in Cotopaxi, rolling music carts for the roving music teacher in Custer County, graphing calculators in Dolores, Orff instruments in LaVeta, iPads in Hayden, and a kiln for K-12 students in Joes!
